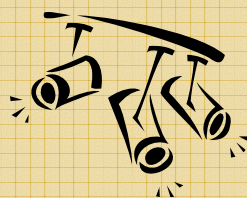
ASD SELECTS NEW VOLUNTEER COORDINATOR
