## **On World AIDS Day, AIDS Services of Dallas to host Ribbon Cutting of New Residence Building**

**WHAT** In celebration of World AIDS Day 2022, AIDS Services of Dallas (ASD) will cut a red ribbon to open its new building, LA MAISON AT 511. This new facility will provide quality, affordable housing for low income and formerly homeless individuals living with or impacted by HIV/AIDS. LA MAISON AT FIVE ELEVEN is ASD's 5<sup>th</sup> residential building in Dallas. The organization received more than \$1M from the City of Dallas and the Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) to remodel, refurbish and expand the property from 8 to 16 units.

Following the ribbon cutting, AIDS Services of Dallas officials will provide a tour of the units, which will be ready for move in by early February.
